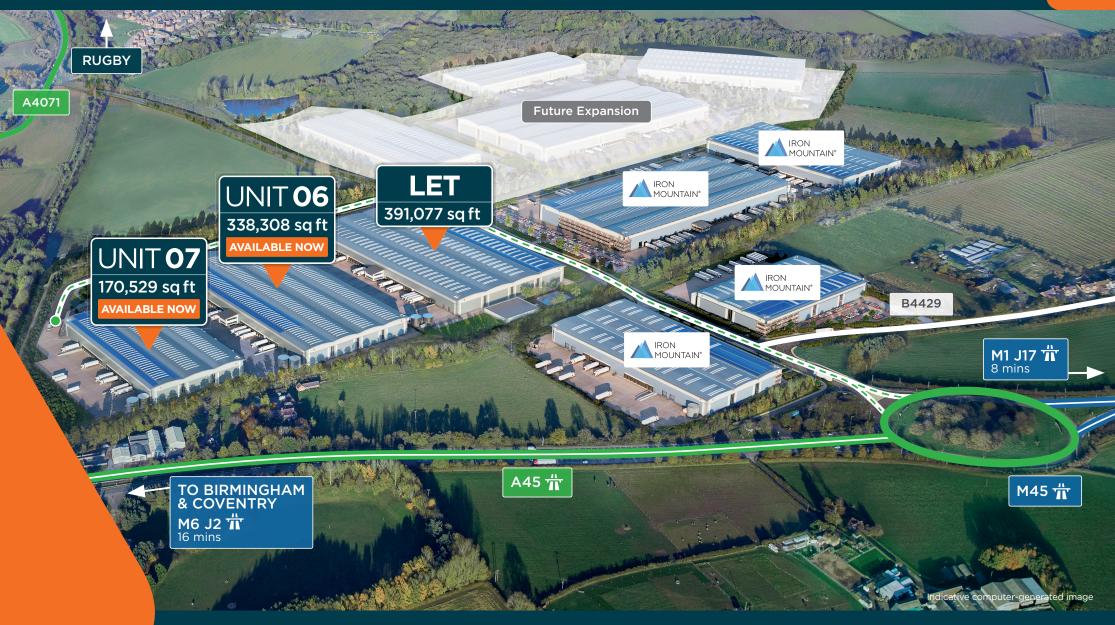

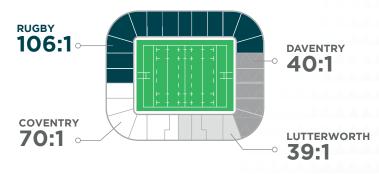


LABOUR

Within the Symmetry Park Rugby catchment (30 minutes drive time), there are 318,822 households and 753,450 residents.

Of these, 486,137 people are of core working age (16-64 years), representing 65% of the catchment's population.

There are 106 employees for every job generated at Symmetry Park Rugby, which compares favourably to comparator sites, where the supply-demand ratios are considerably lower.



AVERAGE WEEKLY SALARY

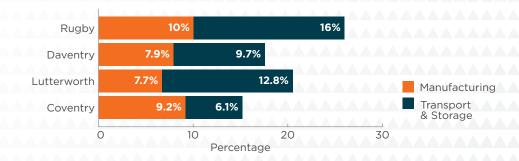
The average weekly salary for a full time warehouse operative in Rugby is £437.

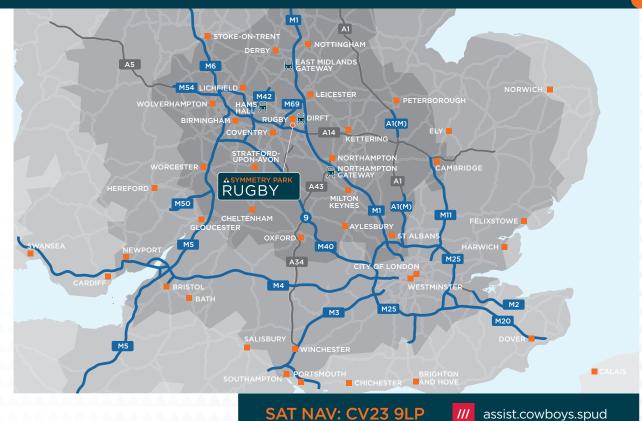
